Plex helps you construct an always-accessible media server no matter what platform you use.

Publisher is an easy-to-use desktop publishing program that offers the flexibility of combining text and pictures to create fancy fliers, brochures and business cards. Learn how to create and edit publications. Editing the publication includes changing the page layout, paper orientation, margins, creating & deleting frames, adding text, changing line spacing and adding borders. Learn how to use Spell Checker, automatic hyphenation and format painter. Add pictures and shapes.
